Memorandum of Understanding

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the **10th day of May Two thousand Twenty Two**, by and between

NATIONAL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY, MANASSERY P.O, KOZHIKODE-673602., THE FIRST PARTY represented herein by its **PRINCIPAL** (hereinafter referred as '**First Party**', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors — in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

MEDLINE INTERNATIONAL, THE SECOND PARTY, and represented herein by its **MANAGING PARTNER** (hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors — in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

NATIONAL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY, MANASSERY P.O, KOZHIKODE-673602., party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

B) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of career guidance, skill development and support to students and professionals in the healthcare sector. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

C) **MEDLINE INTERNATIONAL**, the Second Party is a leading healthcare career consultant and training institute specialized in registration and licensing of healthcare professionals with the health authorities of UAE, Qatar, Oman, Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, and more.

D) Give related information, its branches, and dimensional information about the second party concerned with which the MoU is sworn.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to establish a collaborative relationship between National College of Pharmacy and MEDLINE INTERNATIONAL to provide career guidance and support to students and professionals in the healthcare sector.

SCOPE OF THE MoU

Knowledge Sharing: Both parties agree to share knowledge, information, and resources relevant to healthcare careers.

Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize and fill the gaps in the curriculum so that the students fit into the professional scenario meaningfully.

Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap to benefit students and staff of first party.

Career Guidance: Second Party will offer career guidance and support to students and professionals in the healthcare sector.

Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs.

Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and license of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein

VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period , the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of **Training Partner** , the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Second Party

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Calicut.
