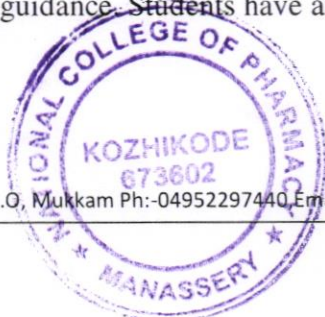
Response:

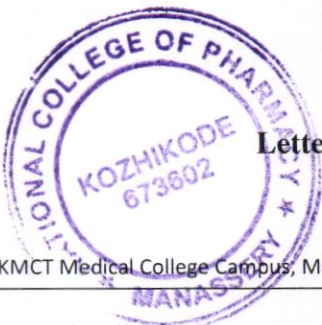

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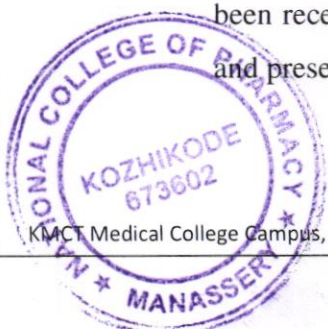
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Certificate of Three Star Recognition from Innovation Cell, Government of India

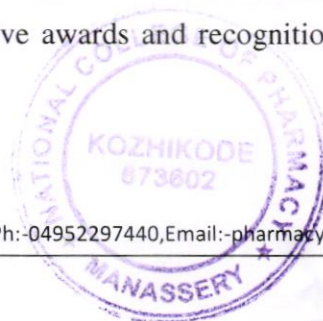


Certificate of Appreciation from KUHS for Kerala Flood Relief
